


# August 19th Meeting Highlights

The Board approve the Fiscal Officer to sign a letter to the Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for high grass nuisance abatement assessment on parcel (22) parcels 1300875, 1301061, 10007056, 1401191, 1306149, 1306148, 1307061, 1307062, 1302727, 1302728, 1302726, 1304740, 1312457, 1401214, 1301417, 1301416, 1307232, 1307233, 1307234, 1307235, 1302476, and 1306171 totaling \$10,700.00.

An update was given for 2901 24th ST SE demolition and asbestos abatement of the property. M&R Environmental was approved by the board to conduct the asbestos abatement. The Stark County Land Bank approved the township's DAP, demolitions assistance program, application that was submitted. The Land Bank's DAP program is to reimburse Canton Township for 50% of the cost expense of the demolitions scheduled for this property.

### Yard Waste

The residential yard waste site opened for the season 7 days a week from 8am-7pm until December 1st. The site requires key card access. Residents of Canton Township, Pike Township, or the Village of East Sparta can be renewed or purchased a card for \$40.

The Board accepted deposits for the residential yard waste cards for two weeks in the amount of \$520.
