



February 5th Meeting Highlights

Fire Department

The Board approved the hiring of Tanner Jones and Cody Walter as full - time Fire Fighter/ Basic and Robert Paulin, Jacob Bostic, and Nicholas Horvatch as part-time Fire Fighter/ Basic. They will be sworn in at the February 27th meeting.

Public Works Department

The Public Works Director provided an update on winter roadway maintenance for the season. So far the Public Works Department has been out treating roadways for snow and ice a total of 34 times. To date labor, equipment, fuel and salt expenses are approximately \$291,900.

The May 6th ballot will have a road renewal levy. ***NOT A NEW TAX. NOT AN INCREASE.*** The Road Levy is the source of funding for ongoing road resurfacing. If the levy is not renewed, road resurfacing will not continue. This is a 2.9 mil, five-year renewal levy, commencing in 2025. This would CONTINUE to cost owner of \$100,000 home \$50.91 per year and generate \$892,000 per year.

Yard Waste

The residential yard waste site will reopen on April 1st. The site will expand the days of operation to seven days a week from 8am-7pm. The annual fee for a key card is \$40 (no increase from last year). If reusing a key card from last year, user can pay by phone or mail a check payable to Canton Township (please include name on card and phone number), or stop in township administration M-F from 8am-3pm. New users will need to stop in the office to sign the registration form and verify residency. This site is for residents of Canton Township, Pike Township, and Village of East Sparta. The Board approved to sign the contract for yard waste hauling with Bull Country for \$175 per container (same cost as 2024).
