Fire Department

activities in the community. This was presented to him at the recent Fire Prevention Breakfast.

Vehicle Technicians for his continued education, certification, and work that he does maintaining the FFD fleet.

The Board approved moving forward with advertising and hiring up to eight new full-time firefighters/EMT.

The Board approved the Fire Chief to participate in the BWC Safety Improvement Grant process.

The Board approved paying out ARPA funded retention bonus payouts to fire personnel in a total amount of \$84,419.

Public Works Department

The Public Works Director updated the Board on an emergency tree service removal of a tree that fell on property of a Village of Meyers Lake resident totaled \$3,500. The tree needed removal due to the danger it posed to roadway travelers. The Board authorized payment as part of the maintenance agreement with the Village of Meyers Lake and has requested full reimbursement from the Village.

Bids received for Faircrest Park projects were opened and forwarded to legal counsel for review.

Residential Yard Waste Drop- Off Site

The residential yard waste site (**commercial yard waste dumping is prohibited**) is currently open on Wednesdays, Saturdays, and Sundays from 9am-7pm. The operation of this site is made possible through Stark Tuscarawas Wayne Joint Recycling District. As of the October 17th meeting, costs have exceed the grant funding amount. STW Joint Recycling District will reimburse the township for costs associated with keeping the site open for the fall season.

Zoning Department

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign a letter to the Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for lawn maintenance/ high grass (4) parcels: 1309342, 1307886, 1304623, and 1304624 totaling \$2,200.00.

The Board declared the following properties as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and order them abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87. 2324 19th St SE, 4101 Dueber Ave SW, 5028 Ridge Ave SE for trash/ debris. 4311 Lincoln St E and 343 Trump Ave NE

for trash/ debris/ junk vehicles.

The 90-day moratorium on new short-term rental applications is still in effect.

The Zoning Director updated the Board on junk vehicles that will be towed from 839 Hollywood.

The Board approved a letter to be sent to all businesses in approved Community Reinvestment Areas.
