Public Works Department

The Public Works Director provided an update of the current totals for winter snow and ice control. Year to date totals are approximately: \$44,000 Labor, \$94,000 fuel/ vehicle direct costs, \$120,000 salt for a season to date total of \$258,000.

The township learned that the Ohio Department of Transportation did not award any funding from the current stimulus program to any Stark County township. Canton Township had submitted a request for funding to resurface and restripe Central Ave SE for \$176,555.00, Warner Rd SE for \$161,423.00, and Millerton SE for \$204,962.00.

Zoning Department

The Board declared the following properties as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and order them abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87 and the Canton Township Property Maintenance Code. 5028 Ridge Ave SE and 2407 14th St SE for trash and debris.

The Board approved a quote of \$9,930 from CRS Contracting Company for the demolition of 2465 Waynesburg Dr SE. With the previously approved asbestos study of \$600 and asbestos removal of \$2,000, the total project cost is estimated at \$12,530 with a 50% cost split (half paid by the township and the other half paid through a grant).

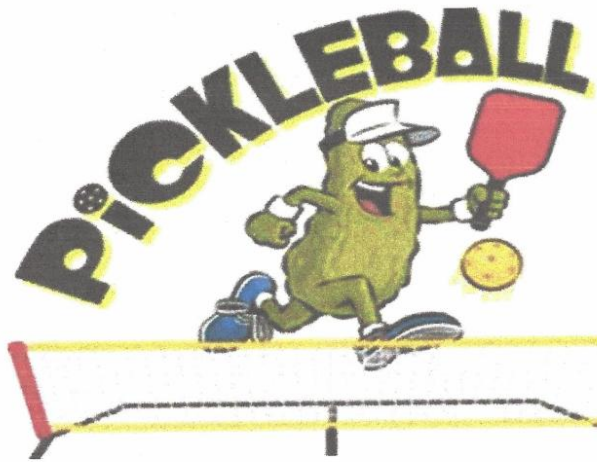
