Fire Department

The Fire Chief updated the Board of the State Fire Marshall Grant that was awarded for the purchase of fire equipment. The department will be purchasing 30 sets of fire boots and 30 sets of fire gloves. The current sets are approaching 10 years old and are beginning to reach end of life use. The total for the purchases will be about \$14,500 with the grant covering \$10,000.

The Board approved replacement of a retaining wall at Meyers Lake Station

Public Works Department

The Board approved resolutions to designate temporary no parking zones on designated township roads during the township Community Day, June 25th 2022 from 8:00am through 11:00 pm. (39th St SW, Davis St SW between Springvale Ave SW and Monica Ave SW, Monica Ave SW between Davis St SW and Faircrest St SW and Springvale Ave SW between Faircrest St SW and Davis St SW), and on designated township roads during the Pro Football Hall of Fame Game, Enshrinement Ceremony, and Concert for Legends from Thursday, August 4th at 8:00am- Sunday, August 7th at 11:59pm.

The Board approved resolutions for ODOT to review & determine a reasonable speed limit on Belden Ave SE and Moore Ave SE.

The 2021/ 2022 road crack seal program has been completed with a cost of \$65,000.

The Public Works Director updated the Board on the increased cost of road salt. As of August 1st, the price will increase by \$.66 per ton.

The Board appreciates the Stark Tuscarawas Wayne Recycling District as they have partnered with Canton Township and utilized storm clean-up funds to pay for the disposal of 6 full containers. This allowed the township to open the site for an extra two days for emergency storm debris clean up. This removes the burden of paying for those containers from the yard waste operating grant in 2022.

The residential yard waste site is open on Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday from 9:00 a.m.- 7:00 p.m. The Board is closely monitoring the expenses against the \$45,100 grant funding amount from Stark Tuscarawas Wayne Recycling District. When funds are exhausted the yard waste site will close. As of the June 7th meeting, the year to date hauling expense was \$3,900.

The Public Works Director updated the Board on recent damage to the brand new shelter occurring from tacks, staples, and nails pushed into the soffit, benches, and poles that now require repair. Signs are being placed reminding users those items are prohibited from use when decorating. As of June 7th meeting, Faircrest Park has 11 bookings for June and Community Park has 8 bookings for June.

The Board of Trustees submitted State of Ohio Capital grant funding consideration for both Faircrest Park and Community Center capital Improvements and recently learned of a Capital Grant award through the State of Ohio in the amount of \$300,000 for Faircrest Park Enhancements.

As a reminder, for safety reasons, dogs need to be leashed in township parks.

General News

The Board submitted a letter to the Stark County Commissioners regarding the existing conditions at Hillcrest Cemetery asking for consideration toward improvements there should Canton Township assume responsibility for the property.

Board authorized a contract with QCS Cleaners for administrative office cleaning for a one-year duration.

Community Center

Due to recent incidents involving rental of the Community Center, the Board increased the cost of the refundable security deposit to \$125 plus \$25 for the door FOB. The Community Center is a great, low-cost, community asset for parties and events, but damage that has been allowed to occur to public property is becoming a major concern at the facility. Our hope is the increased security deposit will ensure more responsible rental usage.

Zoning Department

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign a letter to Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for lawn maintenance/high grass nuisance assessment on (23) parcels: 1307798, 1302711, 1313128, 1312457, 1305320, 1312424, 1301591, 1315065, 1307886, 1302514, 1380054, 1380055, 1380056, 1307061, 1307062, 1305100, 1305101, 1305102, 1305737, 1304876, 1304875, 1305244, and 1312336 totaling \$11,750.00

As of the June 7th meeting, 66 letters have been sent to property owners notifying them of high grass nuisance.

The Board approved the short term rental application. This new application process is for property owners to register their short term rental property per the text amendments added to the Canton Township Zoning Resolution that went into effective on May 28th.
