Fire Department

Board authorized the Board President and Fiscal Officer to execute paperwork necessary for the purchase of a used 2015 Pierce pumper truck with a cost not to exceed \$349,000 once inspection is complete by Fire Chief and Township Fire Mechanic. This pumper will replace an aging engine that will be placed for sale with proceeds offsetting the cost of the replacement pumper.

The Board approved fire gear purchase from Fire Force in an amount not to exceed \$20,986.

Public Works Department

The May 6th ballot will have a road renewal levy. *NOT A NEW TAX. NOT AN INCREASE*. The Road Levy is the source of funding for ongoing road resurfacing. If the levy is not renewed, road resurfacing will not continue. This is a 2.9 mil, five-year renewal levy, commencing in 2025. This would CONTINUE to cost owner of \$100,000 home \$50.91 per year and generate \$892,000 per year.

Township Parks

The Board approved tree removal and stump removal quotes for Wiseland and Faircrest Park property at a total cost of \$6,400. The Faircrest Park work is required as tree debris is damaging structure and will be needed for safety reasons with placement of new playground equipment. Wiseland removal is necessary for safety reasons.
