Stark County Regional Planning Commission conducted the first public meeting for Canton Township residents at the Canton Township Community Center on Wednesday, September 15th to discuss past, ongoing, and future activities planned for public involvement with

The Board approved moving forward with an adjustment in the participation level of the Bureau of Workers Compensation Drug Free Safety Program that once accepted, will yield a 7% savings in BWC premiums paid by the township.

## ***Public Works Department***

The Board made a motion to request the Ohio Department of Transportation to complete a speed study on the portion of Route 800 from Mill Rd to the southern border.

The Public Works Director updated the Board that the 2021 Canton Township Paving Program is about 3/4 of the way completed. Crews will be finishing up the Northwest sections in the next week or two.

The Board received an update the replacement wheel loader that had been purchased is ready. The vendor and manufacturer are in the process of finalizing shipping logistics.

The Faircrest Park capital projects have been placed out for bid by Sol Harris Day and the Board authorized the necessary applications to be made at the Stark County Building Department for all possible projects.

The residential yard waste site is open on Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday from 9:00 a.m.- 7:00 p.m. The Board is closely monitoring the expenses against the \$45,630 grant funding amount from Stark Tuscarawas Wayne Recycling District. When funds are exhausted the yard waste site will close.
