Fire Department News

The Board reviewed demolition quotes for former Fire Station #1.

Chief Smith presented recommendations and costs associated with the repair of Engine 32 pump and transfer case.

Seventeen applications have been received for full time firefighter/ medic positions and interviews will begin July 6th.

Sealed bids were opened for the sale of Station 5 and forwarded to township attorney for review.

Road Department News

The Board signed the 2020 paving contract with Superior paving.

The Public Works Director gave an update on the Canton City Water Department project and an agreement to split the cost of paving Southberry Circle, which became necessary due to the storage of water project heavy equipment on this road.

The purchase of a replacement traffic/ speed indicator unit was approved to replace a 16 year old unit that is outdated and can no longer be repaired as parts are no longer available.

Zoning Department News

The Board declared the following property a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and ordered it abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87 and the Canton Township Property Maintenance Code. Andy & Dency Cilona- 1477 Valentine Cir NW for trash and debris.

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign the letter to Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for trash and debris removal nuisance assessment on 1 parcel: 1400005 totaling \$587.73.
