Public Works Department

The May 6th ballot will have a road renewal levy. *NOT A NEW TAX. NOT AN INCREASE*. The Road Levy is the source of funding for ongoing road resurfacing. If the levy is not renewed, road resurfacing will not continue.

This is a 2.9 mil, five-year renewal levy, commencing in 2025. This would CONTINUE to cost owner of \$100,000 home \$50.91 per year and generate \$892,000 per year.

The Board received an update on the status of large storm water pipe repairs for Cheyenne and Prairie College.
