

Zoning Department

The Board declared the following properties as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and order them abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87.4. 3210 Waynesburg Dr SE, 2939 16th ST NW, 1114 Oak Ave NW, 1125 Brant Ave NW for trash/debris. 1212 Lily Ave NE for unsecure structure. 3324 Allenford Dr SE living in camper.

The Board approve the Fiscal Officer to sign a letter to the Stark County

Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for high grass nuisance abatement assessment on parcel (15) parcels 1306529, 1380055, 1380056, 1308052, 1300875, 1304740, 1304739, 10001854, 10001856, 10001857, 1305910, 1302711, 1301417, 1301416, 1301373 totaling \$7,750.00

Year- to- date the township has notified (158) properties owners of nuisance high grass. (51) parcels were not resolved and resulted in mowing by the township and assessment placed on the tax duplicate.

Yard Waste

The residential yard waste site opened for the season 7 days a week from 8am-7pm until December 1st. The site requires key card access. Residents of Canton Township, Pike Township, or the Village of East Sparta can be renewed or purchased a card for \$40.

The Board accepted deposits for the residential yard waste cards for two weeks in the amount of \$1,720.

General News

Approved to have the hallways in the Community Center restored following remodel work through Ohio Services Plus for \$650.

Approved purchase of commercial refrigerator and freezer for Community Center not to exceed \$4,300.

Renewed Everbridge services contract for one additional year in the amount of \$4,980. Currently approximately 200 users are signed up for township alerts. It is unlikely the service will continue beyond this year with the relative low number of users. To sign-up for alerts download the Everbridge app from your play store, search Canton Township OH.

The Fiscal Officer provided the Board with the recent audit results The Ohio Auditor of State requires townships to undergo biannual audits. The audit for 2023 and 2024 was recently concluded and has been submitted to the Auditor's office for review and acceptance, once this has occurred the audit is available to the public. We are proud to share that once again no findings nor citations are being issued and so this essentially constitutes "passing" the audit.
