



January 17th Meeting Highlights

Fire Department



The Board approved to hire David Phillips and Michael Stevenson as part-time firefighters/ EMT Basic with a start date of 2/6/23. Trustee Nichols issued the oath of office to Michael Stevenson. We wish you both a long and healthy career!

The Board finalized steps for placement of a fire levy on the May ballot. The department continues operating with funding levels established a decade ago while department member compensation, need for full squad replacement, and other capital needs must be addressed.

The Board approved to increase the hourly pay scale for part-time fire department members.

The Fire Chief updated the Board on roof and siding damage from a recent storm at Station #2. After review, it was determined the insurance would handle the cost of a full roof replacement and siding repairs.

Public Works Department

The Board approved the 2023 Storm Water Pollution Plan for Canton Township, as required by the EPA.

The Public Work Director provided an update regarding 2022-2023 winter snow/ ice road maintenance. Crews have been out on seven occasions with a total cost of approximately \$84,500 (this includes labor, equipment, salt/ materials).

The Board approved the purchase of a new zero turn mower for parks and cemetery mowing.

The residential yard waste is now closed. The final total of hauling expense was \$37,755. The operation of this site is made possible through a grant provided by Stark Tuscarawas Wayne Joint Recycling District.
