Fire Department News

Trustee Nichols issued the Oath of Office to Timothy Wagner as a part-time Firefighter/ Medic. We wish you a long and healthy career!

The Fire Chief provided the Board with updates on the Station 3 retaining wall and property enhancements.

The Board received an update on station staffing. Through the remainder of the year there will be times when the department will fall under full staffing.

The Board received an update on a state grant opportunity CTFD put forward addressing personnel retention as well as hiring and payroll cost considerations. Total grant possibilities amount to \$251K spread over a two-year period, but many agencies across the state have applied and available funding is far outpaced by requests.

Zoning Department

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign a letter to the Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for lawn maintenance/high grass nuisance assessment on (6) parcels: 1302713, 1301441, 1302764, 1305576, 1304457, 1304458 totaling: \$3,100.00

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign letter to Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for nuisance abatement assessment on (1) parcel: 1315065 totaling \$1,790.00.

The board declared the following property as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and order it abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87. 3255 Amford St SE for trash and debris.

As of the August 2nd meeting, 101 letters have been sent to property owners notifying them of high grass nuisance.

The Board received an update from the Zoning Director on status of efforts related to the top 5 ongoing nuisance properties within the township and action being taken legally and with owners to bring the properties into compliance.

The Board asked for welcome letters to be mailed to all residential addresses that result in a property transfer. As part of the welcome letter, we will include instructions about the need for application for short term rental usage of properties to educate new property owners not familiar with the requirements in Canton Township.

Public Works Department

The Public Works Director updated the Board on culvert projects and repairs currently being done to prepare roads that are to be resurfaced in the upcoming months.

Below are the Canton Township 2022 streets to be resurfaced. This list was finalized following a second bid process as the first list included more roads and had to be rejected due to the bid costs coming in well beyond what cost estimates and budget would allow. This was due to the considerable rise in the cost of paving materials and labor this year compared last year.
