The Public Works Director began initial discussions regarding the 2024 road surfacing program options and road striping plans.



The extensive interview process included many quality applicants and representation from the Board of Trustees, Fiscal Officer, the Chairpersons from the Canton Township Zoning Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals, and Assistant Zoning Director. We congratulate Todd and welcome him to our team!

The Zoning Commission will conduct a public hearing on March 28th at 6:00pm to review a proposed text amendment to the Canton Township Zoning Resolution regarding adult establishments. This text amendment will add zoning regulations similar to nearby communities. Stark County Regional Planning will review the text and make recommendations.

The Board approved the Thrasher Group to create a bid package for the demolition of North Industry School.
