General News

The Board approved 2022 permanent appropriations in the amount of \$9,076,39.

Fire Department

Received an update from CTFD Chief Chris Smith regarding ongoing staffing concerns the fire industry faces. CTFD is experiencing the same trends as seen throughout the industry. Maintaining adequate staffing remains an ongoing concern for our department. The Chief provided an update on interviews for recent openings and interest remains low.

Public Works Department

Bids for asphalt patching materials were opened and forwarded to the Township Attorney for review.

ODOT has posted new signs following completion of a speed study conducted on an ODOT maintained road, State Route 800, lowering the speed by 5 MPH from Mill Street south to 53rd Street. The speed is now 40 MPH.

The Board approved up to \$3,000 in repairs to a 2009 Ventrac mower that is used to exclusively mow nuisance properties throughout the year. 2021 was a record number of nuisance mows within our township and caused a lot of wear and tear on the equipment.

The Board approved the Public Works Director to sign the 2022 Yard Waste Host Site Block Grant Agreement between Canton Township and the Stark-Tuscarawas-Wayne Joint Solid Waste Management District with the grant amount being \$45,110.00 for 2022. The operation expense will include a \$10 per container increase in cost for yard waste hauling this year. The site will open no later than 3/30/22 and possibly sooner if containers could be made available. Hours will remain the same as last year WED/SAT/SUN 9am - 7pm.

The Board approved the Board President to sign the following: 2021 NPDES Small MS4 general permit annual report, the 2022 revision of the Canton Township storm water management program, as well as the Board approval for the 2022 storm water pollution prevention plan (SWP3) for the Public Works/Admin office.

The Board authorized the Pro Football HOF Enshrinement Festival use of any township property for use during the Balloon Classic as lift off, landing, or target zones.

Received an update the demolition of the current shelter in Faircrest Park in front of the new shelter and restrooms will be completed soon.

Received an update that Community Park is expected to be opened by April

1, or sooner at the discretion of the Public Works Director.

The Board approved the spring ball field assignments for use at Community Park and Mikunda Field (at the Administration Building):

The Board declared the following properties as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and order them abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87 and the Canton Township Property Maintenance Code. 4707 Cleveland Ave SW and Parcel 1310193/ 1313930 on Central Ave SE for trash and debris.

The Board approved a resolution to amend the Canton Township Zoning Resolution regarding short term rentals. The resolution will be forward to Stark County Regional Planning for review. Following the SCRPP review, a public hearing with the Canton Township Zoning Commission and a separate hearing with the Board of Trustees will take place regarding the proposed amendment.

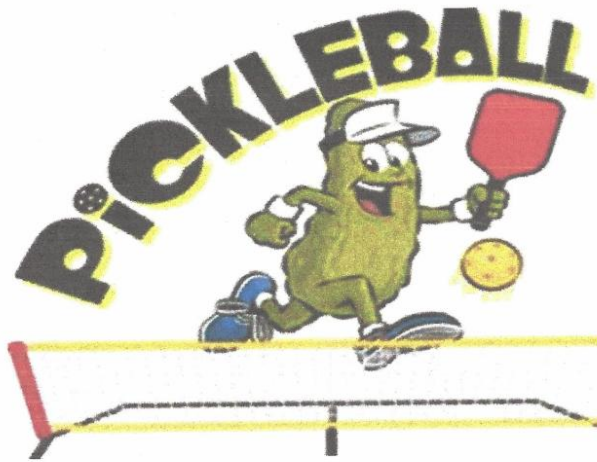
