Fire Department

The Board approved the use of Pradco for the Canton Township Fire Department assessment for internal promotional purposes.

Chief Smith provided an update regarding recent PSC Metals scrap fire. 53 personnel and 1.3 million gallons of water along with support from 10 departments/agencies were required to extinguish the fire. Ohio EPA was on the scene. AEP was also required to de-energize high voltage lines in the vicinity of the heat of the fire. Canton Township Public Works Department closed roads and supplied 142.8 gallons of diesel fuel to help control and extinguish the fire. Other miscellaneous costs incurred by the township, outside of the direct regular CTFD operations, totaled \$2,230.00 PSC Metals company officials are meeting with Canton City Utilities regarding water hydrants onsite. CTFD leadership is meeting with company representatives to discuss ongoing fire mitigation strategies. Canton Township has no other regulatory authority to impose compliance of any recommendations. The recurring nature of fires at this facility and resources and safety of personnel required to fight these fires continues to be a primary concern of the township Board of Trustees.

Zoning Department

The Board declared the following properties as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and ordered them abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87 and the Canton Township Property Maintenance Code. 3221 Allenford Dr SE, 311 Baumford Ave SE, 403 Baumford Ave SE and Parcel #1305737 Charlotte Ave SE all for trash/debris.

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign letter to Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for lawn maintenance/high grass nuisance assessment on 19 parcels: 1302711, 1307798, 1304875, 1304876, 1305244, 1308399, 1302896, 1301441, 1306824, 1306954, 1307886, 1306289, 1306290, 1303049, 1380055, 1380054, 1380056, 1312424, 1315065, totaling \$10,350.00.

As of the 6/8/21 meeting, the township has mowed 37 high grass nuisance

properties. 11 properties were mowed by the property owner following notification of high grass nuisance.

The Board approved a contract with Slesnick Iron & Metal Co. for junk motor vehicle disposal as the township continues to pursue legal remedies to address a number of vehicles throughout the community that violate township zoning regulations.

The Board will conduct a public hearing on June 22nd at 6:00 p.m. to consider the application CA-3-21 from Larry Bowling at 3650 Cleveland Ave SE for reclassification of property from a B2- Neighborhood Business District to a B3- Commercial Business District. Stark County Regional Planning and Canton Township Zoning Commission reviewed this application at prior meetings and recommended approval of the application.

The Zoning Director updated the Board regarding the scrapyards on Georgetown Rd. He stated that after an investigation into a recent fire at the location and business operations it revealed the business lacked a conditional use permit to operate in the township. He is working with the business to complete the necessary steps to obtain a permit.
