Fire Department

Township Parks

The Board accepted park rental receipts for two weeks in the amount of \$1,250.00.

Public Works Department

Thank you, residents! The positive vote of confidence will continue funding for ongoing road resurfacing, without increasing taxes.

The Board heard road resurfacing bid tallies for the 2025 Resurfacing Projects, that came in under the engineers estimates. The bids have been forwarded to township legal counsel for review.

The Board approved the purchase of a used forklift in the amount of \$9,900 to replace the current inoperable forklift.

The Board approved a request from Bellstores to finish install of sidewalk along their new store and Faircrest Street SW with Bellstores picking up 100% of the cost.

The Board authorized the Public Works Director to proceed with placement of a Summit E-Cycle container at the recycling area of the township admin building at zero cost to the township.

The Board authorized including Canton Local School District crack seal materials needs (parking lots) in with township roads crack seal to be purchased this year to help obtain a better cost and as part of a mutual services agreement the township put in place with the district.



Zoning Department
