Zoning Department

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign letter to Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for lawn maintenance/high grass nuisance assessment on (10) parcels: 1303513, 1303235, 1309394, 1301856, 1315065, 1302514, 1308052, 1314996, 1312457 and 1305320 totaling \$ 5,300.00

As of the 8/31/21 meeting, the township has sent 184 letters notifying property owners of high grass nuisance. 111 properties have been mowed by the township. If mowed by the township, a letter is then sent to the Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for lawn maintenance/high grass nuisance assessment.

General Updates

The Board approved two new additional electronic message signs. One will be placed at the Administration Building and one at Station #3 on Parkway NW.

The Board approved the purchase of 10 additional welcome to Canton Township signs to replace damaged or stolen signs and for replacement of old signs.
