The Faircrest Bridge Project originally scheduled to be completed by August 17th, is still under construction. The Stark County Engineer is working to have it open prior to the start of the school year. Detour signs will remain posted until the project is completed.

Zoning Department

The Board declared the following properties as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and ordered them abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87 and the Canton Township Property Maintenance Code, 511 Cole Ave SE and parcel #1314949 on Lucinda Ave SE both for trash and debris.

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign letter to Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for lawn maintenance/high grass nuisance assessment on (11) parcels: 1308399, 1301591, 1400839, 1309342, 1380055, 1380054, 1380056, 1303049, 1315001, 1312336, and 1307798 totaling \$6,350.00.

The Zoning Director provided an update to the Board regarding the results of the August 2nd Board of Zoning Appeals Meeting. A variance was granted to the owner at 3970 Faircrest ST SE to build a garage and an area

variance and conditional use permit was granted to Boss Property Management at 3911 Georgetown St NE to operate a scrap yard in an I1 & I2 District.
