Public Works Department

An invitation to bid on Faircrest Park Projects, that include an amphitheater, Armed Forces memorial, and utility building remodel will be received through October 17th at 2pm. [For bid details click here.](#)

The Public Works Director updated the Board on the current street crack sealing project. This maintenance work will help to preserve streets that have been recently paved.

The large ditch located at Faircrest Park has recently been filled in. A large culvert pipe was installed through the parking lot to relocate the water from the ditch. This was done to improve the beauty of the park, establish more usable greenspace, provide additional parking for larger events, and make it easier to maintain.

Residential Yard Waste Drop- Off Site

The residential yard waste site (**commercial yard waste dumping is prohibited**) is currently open on Wednesdays, Saturdays, and Sundays from 9am-7pm. The operation of this site is made possible through Stark Tuscarawas Wayne Joint Recycling District grant funding in the amount of \$40,300 for 2023. As of the September billing, \$33,525 of the grant has already been spent on the hauling costs.

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign a letter to the Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for lawn maintenance/ high grass (14) parcels: 1302764, 1305576, 1380055, 1380056, 1302711, 1309342, 1315065, 1312424, 1301441, 1302514, 1307061, 1307062, 1303150 and 1304740 totaling \$7,900.00.

The Board declared the following properties as a nuisance as deemed by the

Zoning Director, and order them abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87. 3942 Paradise St SW for trash/ debris/ unsecured structure.

The Board heard from residents during the public speaks portion of the meeting regarding short term rental regulations in Canton Township. The Board placed a 90 day moratorium on accepting new short term rental applications to review of the process for application and enforcement procedures.

The Board of Zoning Appeals will conduct a public hearing on Monday, October 2nd at 7:00 pm to hear the following appeals:

- 522 Malhaven St SW- Parcel No. 1308255- R2- Residential
Applicant is seeking a 10-foot variance to the rear yard setback and a 5-foot variance to the side yard setback for an accessory building in a R2- Residential District.

- 5512 Frey Ave SW- Parcel No. 1309576- RR- Residential
Applicant is seeking a 3- foot variance to the maximum height requirement, 1-foot variance to the side yard setback, and a variance to exceed the square footage of the primary use structure for an accessory building in a RR-Rural Residential District.

- 3407 Prairie College St SW- Parcel No. 1312291- RR- Residential
Applicant is seeking a conditional use for a home occupation in a RR-Rural Residential District.
