Zoning Department

The Board declared the following properties as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and order them abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87.4. 337- 33rd St SW and 2134 Calvin Ave SW for trash/ debris and 216 Ruggles Ave SE for no permit carport.

The Board approve the Fiscal Officer to sign a letter to the Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for high grass nuisance abatement assessment on parcel (13) parcels 1304875, 1305244, 1304876, 1302820, 1303301, 1303300, 1307798, 1307234, 1307232, 1307233, 1302476, 1306171, 1307734 totaling \$6,450.00

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign letter to Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for nuisance abatement assessment on (1) parcel 1302567 totaling \$873.00

Year- to- date the township has notified (180) properties owners of nuisance high grass. (51) parcels were not resolved and resulted in mowing by the township and assessment placed on the tax duplicate.

The Board passed a resolution that accounts for changes in State of Ohio law pertaining to zoning change notifications; Canton Township opted to expand notification of change requests beyond the minimum required notification now required by the new legislation.

The Canton Township Board of Zoning Appeals will be conducting a public hearing Monday, July 14, 2025 at 7:00 pm at the Canton Township Administration Building 4711 Central Avenue SE Canton, Ohio to hear the following applications for appeal:

Appeal #1256-25 Gear Ohio LLC 215 Trump Ave NE- B3 Commercial Business

Applicant is requesting a conditional use for truck and trailer storage in a Commercial Business District. This property is located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 12 in Canton Township, Stark County, Ohio.

Yard Waste

The residential yard waste site opened for the season 7 days a week from 8am-7pm until December 1st. The site requires key card access. Residents of Canton Township, Pike Township, or the Village of East Sparta can be renewed or purchased a card for \$40.

The Board accepted deposits for the residential yard waste cards for two weeks in the amount of \$1,080.
