Fire Department News



Welcome to Canton Township!

Trustee Nichols issued the Oath of Office to Jared Hagen & Tessa Yurich both part-time Firefighter/ EMT Basics and Nathaniel Fabinak as a part-time Firefighter/Medic. We wish you a long and healthy career!

The Board authorized purchase of two backup power generators. One for CTFD Station #3 and one for CTFD Station #1/Community Center (Station #2 already has one). It was noted there is a 40 week back-order delay and costs are rising. The Community Center is a Red Cross designated location in case of disaster and these purchases address possible delays in emergency response as loss of power, it can take 5-8 minutes to manually raise each station door to get Fire/ EMS equipment out.

General News

The Board approved Resolution 07-02-22 to place a Fire Levy on the November ballot to replace the existing 4.0 mill Fire Levy, with an increase of an additional 1.9 Mills. The Fire Department has been operating on the same revenue for 10 years. During that time, they have experienced increased cost and losing staff to higher paying departments.

The Board approved Resolution 07-04-22 to create a separate fund for One Ohio funds. The One Ohio funds are monies received from the governmental lawsuit against the opioid distributors.

Zoning Department

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign a letter to the Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for lawn maintenance/high grass nuisance assessment on (24) parcels: 1301591, 1309342, 1315065, 1307886, 1307734, 1312424, 1307798, 1307061, 1307062, 1302711, 1308052, 1304876, 1304875, 1305244, 1302514, 1380055, 1380056, 1380054, 1305737, 1305102, 1305101, 1305100, 1307480 and 1313644 totaling: \$12,400.00

The board declared the following properties as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and order them abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87. 517 Carrolldale Ave SE, 3255 Amford St SE, 2629 6th St SE all for trash and debris.

As of the July 19th meeting, 98 letters have been sent to property owners notifying them of high grass nuisance.

Public Works Department



The Public Works Director discussed with the Board recent vandalism at parks and around the township. The Board approved resolution 07-03-22, A resolution to adopt picnic shelter rules and regulation for Canton Township owned parks.

PICNIC SHELTER RULES

- Please place all trash in trash containers
- NO Alcoholic Beverages are allowed
- NO Firearms, Weapons or Fireworks are allowed
- Staples, pins, nails, and tacks, are not allowed
- Confetti is not permitted
- Paper and tape must be removed after use
- Keep picnic area and shelter clean
- Pets must be leashed and cleaned up after
- NO standing or walking on tables or countertop
- Amplified music and sounds are prohibited and the Canton Township noise ordinance must be followed
- NO Fires are permitted other than in the grill for food preparation
- Parties that have properly rented the picnic shelter have priority use over the general public usage
- NO Inflatables, dunk tanks, climbing walls or kiddie pools are permitted
- NO bicycles, roller skates, skate boards, ATV's, UTV's, dirt bikes or motorcycles are permitted in or around the picnic shelter

The Public Works Director provided an update regarding efforts to remove and repurpose playground equipment at Walker Elementary for possible use at township parks.

The Board approved to close Faircrest St SE for Meet the Teams night on August 26th from 5:00pm-9:00pm upon request from Canton Local School Administration for purposes of extra parking.

The residential yard waste site is open on Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday from 9:00 a.m.- 7:00 p.m. The Board is closely monitoring the expenses against the \$45,100 grant funding amount from Stark Tuscarawas Wayne Recycling District. When funds are exhausted the yard waste site will close. As of the June 21st meeting, the year to date hauling expense was \$12,300.00.
