

May 11th Meeting Highlights

Fire Department

The Board approved to hire Cindi Annen as an independent contractor to serve as the CPR Training Coordinator.

The Board approved the purchase of a new Pierce Pumper Tanker from Atlantic Emergency Solutions at a cost not to exceed \$534,621.00. The new Pierce pumper tanker purchase is happening several months earlier than planned to avoid anticipated price increases and to take advantage of available discounts. The new pumper tanker will complete the major replacement of CTFD firefighting apparatus to take our department over the next 15 years, except now the department's three primary squads, which all will need to be replaced over the coming years, become a budgetary focus. The new pumper tanker will enable the department to replace a 2006 engine with 94,000 miles on it that was refurbished 3 years ago, allowing it to go into reserve status. CTFD will be able to retire and potentially sell a current tanker as the new unit will have a large water storage capacity.

The Board approved \$19,000 for concrete work to the driveway at Station #2.

CTFD was able to retrofit an existing pickup to serve as a brush fire response unit. Utilizing in-house skill and labor at substantial savings over outsourcing or purchasing a new unit, the township was able to incorporate this response unit into the fleet at a total cost of \$5,469.16.

The Community Center door replacement was approved at a cost of \$6,166. This door will enable an added access point that will have a key FOB secured entry for individuals using the center as part of Bridge Point Learning Center.

The Board declared the following property as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and ordered it abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87 and the Canton Township Property Maintenance Code. 2367 17th ST SE for trash and debris.

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign letter to Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for lawn maintenance/high grass nuisance assessment on 16 parcels: 1307886, 1306639, 1400236, 1314996, 1309342, 1304457, 1304458, 1306289, 1306290, 1303049, 1302711, 1307798, 1304875, 1304876, 1305244, 1308399, totaling \$8,800.00

The Public Works Director updated the Board that the price of salt for winter road maintenance would increase from \$68.22 per ton to \$70.22 per ton next year.
