Fire Department

The Fire Department will be swearing in eight full-time members on Friday March 22nd. Five members are current part-time members being promoted: Kris Moll, Jeremy Rieger, Micael Stevenson, Nate Weisel, and Tessa Yurich.

The three additional members are Tanner Dodge, Jared Lee, and Michael Wiseman.

These hires were made possible with community support and passing the fire levy in May of 2023.

Public Works Department

The Board approved the spring township ballfield assignments for the following youth organizations:

The Board approved the 2024 resurfacing program to be advertised for bid. Once bids have been finalized the list of roads will be communicated.

The Board accepted a grant from Stark Tuscarawas Wayne Joint Recycle District to complete the yard waste site conversion to a privatized site.

Residential Yard Waste

The residential yard waste is moving from a grant funded site to a privatized site. Residents of Canton Township, Pike Township, and Village of East Sparta will be able to purchase a \$40 gate access key card at the Canton Township Administrative Office- 4711 Central Ave SE beginning Tuesday, March 26th between the office hours of Monday- Friday 8am-3pm. Fire Department

The Board approved to purchase Platform Lift from LEPPPO for \$22,500 using BWC grant money of \$16,875. The balance will be split between Public Works, Fire, and General Fund as all departments will benefit from the equipment use.

Zoning Department

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign a letter to the Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for board up assessment (3) parcel: 1401297, 1305099, 1306171 totaling \$1,282.50

General News

The Board accepted \$2,950 in new Community Day donations raising the total tally to \$18,400 for 2024. Which will go to offset the many costs involved in hosting an event of this magnitude.

The Board approved 2024 Permanent Appropriations in the amount of \$10,788,316.35.
